Mission is to increase opportunity to experience music not otherwise available among PK-12. 3-12gr high performance level expected. Looking to expand reach, incl prof. development. No tuition, cost shared by YMF-district. Class performances. Neighborhood orchestra. Looking for presence in MV schools. Some classes during school, could be afterwards. Capped classes at 15; depending on school.

Robin: \$37.5K budgeted to MVCC for last year, then additional \$5K. Hard to say how much will be available yearly.

MTMS: 19 basketball courts w/o nets. Great community interest in local outdoor space as articulated by WMVRA (perhaps they can match grant?) – outdoors needs equipment to welcome the 67 unanticipated local neighborhood influx of pupils (yeah!). Enriches campus, beautifies neighborhood

<u>Walgrove</u>: 400+ attended last year's Studio Lab Game Day; showcases school, recruiting tool. Not enough equipment last year. Hands on design/build, community Teaching Event. Beloved. Great community-booster (w/ wild-lands, social-emotional learning) all around.

<u>Richland</u>: Dual language is very popular; turned away families. Kids grow FAST need to keep library one step ahead. Important for MV reputation, instructional through-path with Twain/VHS.

<u>Grand View</u>: from gardening teacher; recycling center to process BIC waste – compost it! Teaches responsibility, stewardship, community aide and spirit, recycling skills.

Webster: Very successful robotics pilot needs extending beyond one

classroom. Lots of collaborative work among kids, talking, planning. Need more LEGO kits for second classroom. Very popular, zeitgeist. MVES: Library needing more books, requested Our Great States. Needs new, full set.
