 - *David Lee from Venice High is coordinating a task force to get community involvement.
 - *The VH Alumni Assoc. is also seeking additional information on timing of the auditorium retrofit, they are still hearing the completion date "2022". The auditorium has been out of use for 6 years.

Further, we would include a Q&A session with the author and our local HS media arts and/or visual arts students. We will work with David Lee from VH regarding possible Q&A session. *Discuss reaching out to Boundless Brilliance to host a presentation to EACC and an additional Web event that can include the community.
