



Print vs. Email/Social Media

 $Newsletter\ reaches > 97+\%$

+ placed at library, recreation center, businesses, and other locations

Email/Social Media reaches < 5%

Spanish uses ~30% more words

By the phenomenon of language information density, translation causes either an expansion or contraction in length.

The 8-page newsletter would become a 12-page newsletter, raising the printing costs by ~30%.

- * Ethnicity does not inherently create need





Digital Publication with Translation Tools

Web Content Accessibility 2.0

- Most popular standards for web accessibility.
- Includes several criteria pertaining to language and multilingualism.
 - * Every page (as well as different passages and phrases) can be "programmatically determined" by software.
 - Users must have a way to identify potentially unfamiliar words, such as idiom, jargon, and abbreviations.
 - * Any text that is more complex than a secondary education level comes with supplementary content that people at this reading level can understand, such as a simpler text summary with illustrations.
 - * When a word's pronunciation is ambiguous in context (such as the present and past tenses of the verb *read*), the website explicitly identifies the word's correct pronunciation.

General Computer Access

Public computers and internet access are available to customers in good standing. To use a computer or access Wi-Fi, customers need a library card and PIN. If you do not have a PIN or have forgotten it, you can request a PIN online or by calling a LA County Library. Customers who are ineligible for a library card can request a card for computer use only. Computer time is limited to 2 hours per day. Printing is free up to the first 10 pages (per day); each additional page is 15¢. Computers are unavailable 15 minutes before the library closes.

Computers are assigned on a first-available basis. Where reservations are available, a computer reservation can be made once per day by calling a LA County Library location or on the library computer during your session. Reservations cannot be made through our website. Reservations can be made for the same day or up to 3 days in advance. Reservations are automatically cancelled if you are more than ten minutes late logging on. For more information, please review our <u>Acceptable Use Policy</u> for Public Access Computers.

Linguistic Isolation depends

- On the ability of all adults in a household to speak English
- * All adults speak another language and none speaks English 'very well.'
- Adult is defined as age 14 or older.



Households would still be counted in linguistic isolation even if a member under the age of 14 may speak English "very well".

Recap & Solution

- Printing and distributing newsletters is the best way to reach the most stakeholders
- MarVista.org is understood in every language (domain names are universal)
- MarVista.org uses Web Content Accessibility 2.0 that translates every page into over 100 languages
- * Spanish translation services needed by < 3% of Mar Vista stakeholders. No location available. The 97% should not be denied.
- Newsletters left at every doorstep, in the library, local businesses, etc. providing more than 100% saturation.
- MarVista.org should be on all material and should continue to be prominent on newsletters
