- 1. I spoke to several business owners:
 - 1) Sunny Grill: Business is down due to Venice Road Diet (less parking, drive-thru less accessible) and down due to no in-door dining with COVID. Also reported that unhoused neighbors have broken into her patio and parking garage next door, stolen three bikes and vandalized property.
 - 2) Yum Yum: Business is down 20% since Homeless Encampment outside door.
 - 3) Liquor Store: Business is stable (people drink alcohol when happy or sad). Occasionally unhoused neighbor from encampment steals items from store.
 - 4) Dry-Cleaner: Business is down 60% (40% COVID, 20% Homeless Encampment next to parking lot).
 - 5) CVS: cashier says unhoused neighbor steals item from store about 1 per shift.

- 1. Goal: decrease number of tents by 20% per year; we have **increased by 28%** in 10mo.
