#### MOTION:

- (1) We move that the City of Los Angeles, in collaboration with the County of Los Angeles:
  - Immediately provide a plan, and funding, to designate new, low-barrier safe-camping and safe-parking sites within location and without criminalizing un-housed people living outside the site
  - Provide an explanation of the services that will be provided at each of these locations
  - Provide a map of these locations so that community members can know where they can go to find safe camping/parking, and to help direct those who need it through non-punitive outreach
  - Fully support and execute upon CF-21-0113, in which Councilmembers Raman and Bonin in their move to get federal funding to accelerate Project Roomkey within City of LA, with no cost to our city.
- (2) We ask that Mayor Eric Garcetti immediately direct his administration to:
  - Submit all outstanding FEMA reimbursement requests
  - Execute his legal right to commandeer empty hotel rooms to provide shelter and services to the unhoused community who are currently forced to live on the street
  - Investigate all potential avenues of support in submitting these reimbursement requests, including taking up the Los Angeles Business Council's offer of organizing volunteers to support the City in filling out and submitting the requests
