POLICY MOTION #1: MVCC Recommendations for future MetroRail projects to enhance Westside/regional/countywide mobility

The Mar Vista Community Council supports the following two large rail projects for inclusion in the Metro Long Range Transportation Plan:

a) Metro Rail line from West LA / LAX to Valley, and

b) Direct Metro Rail (or Metrolink) line from LAX to Union Station via the Harbor Subdivision Rail Right of Way.

c) Inclusion of sidewalk/curb/median repairs for the City of Los Angeles

d) Inclusion of key parking structures, bus benches and bike corrals for multimodal mobility/transportation for the City of Los Angeles

2) Discussion and possible motion: Smart Benches for Great Street Venice Blvd. **POLICY MOTION #2:**

Whereas LA City currently owns but a small portion of Great Street Venice Blvd. and Whereas, the rest of Great Street Venice Blvd. is owned by Caltrans, and Whereas, LA City owns Venice/Inglewood adjacent to the Mar Vista Library and the side streets off of Venice Blvd. just outside of the Venice Blvd. Caltrans right-of-way, Therefore, a Smart Bench is proposed for Venice at Inglewood near the Mar Vista Library and/or on a side street adjacent to Venice Blvd. just outside of the Caltrans right-of-way.
