- 5. Special Orders
 - a. CD11 Mobility Deputy Alek Bartrosouf's report
 - The new, upgraded signal at Palms/Sawtelle works now.
 - The next major signal upgrade is planned for Centinela/Venice.
 - Major signals being designed are at Barrington/Gateway, McLaughlin/Palms, and Graham/Sawtelle.
 - Initiatives being worked on at CD11 include Westside Fast Forward and the Sepulveda Transit Project.
 - The Parking Demand Study is still being worked on, with major unresolved issues including funding and geography. Both CD11 staff member Alek Bartrosouf and CD5 transportation deputy Jay Greenstein were encouraged to work with the MVCC on a defined and workable Parking Demand Study.
 - The LADOT speed hump program was being worked on by Len Nguyen and the LADOT to determine what metrics and qualifications were needed to prioritize and approve speed humps in requested locations.
 - LA Now Microtransit includes students accessing LAUSD schools. Ongoing discussions with the principal of Venice High School with respect to the minimum age, and whether seat belts were going to be mandatory and provided for riders, are underway. <u>Luz.echavarria@lacity.org</u> is the contact person for this program.
 - b. Street Improvements Zone 1: discussion with CD5 Transportation Deputy Jay Greenstein
 - There is a large number of requests for dead-ends and blocked residential streets, and they are ALL likely to be denied by the City, including the request for Tabor and Westminster to be a cul-de-sac in Zone 1.
 - The LADOT Neighborhood Traffic Management Department was terminated in the last economic downturn/recession.
 - *Red-curbing/no parking zones are being considered for Glendon and Ellenda Avenues in Zone* 1.
