a. CD11 Mobility Deputy Alek Bartrosouf’s report

Councilmember Bonin's [Moving Forward Mar Vista](#) action plan is complete (with speed humps coming in a matter of weeks) You can see the full list on the website, but the latest addition was the long-awaited left-turn phasing signal at Centinela and Venice. It also included dedicated right-turn phasings to facilitate easy flow through the intersection. For speed humps, these are the approved segments moving forward:

Mar Vista has received many new signals recently: left turn phasing at Palms/Sawtelle, Venice/Wade, and Centinela/Venice. As part of [Westside Fast Forward](#), more are in the works (but still many many many months away). In this larger batch, Palms/McLaughlin and Barrington/Gateway are the next ones coming in and are already designed. Timelines announced at a later date (when we know them).

MVCC Parking Study - CD11 senior staff will be present at the MVCC board meeting on December 10 to provide an update. Unfortunately they couldn't attend this evening.

Metro Bikeshare - [here](#) is an updated station map with new locations in Playa Vista. More are coming to Del Rey, Playa Vista, and hopefully Mar Vista. We will be getting a station at the Bundy/Expo station for Mar Vistans to traverse to and from the Expo line.

LA Now is still humming along. Can T/I suggest that MVCC schedule LAnow postings on social media to promote the service? We want to ensure Mar Vistans continue to learn about this exclusive service.

There are other minor spot improvements still in the oven, as they are implemented in the future they will be brought to the committee's attention.

Selena Inouye also reported accidents on McLaughlin Ave at Westminster between Palms and Charnock.

It was questioned as to whether LA Now could pick up middle schoolers, but high school students were certainly acceptable with respect to age and being picked up with parents.

a. T&I and Comm Plan: Further discussion and an amended motion regarding an MVCC Transportation survey for input to the Palms - Mar Vista - Del Rey Community Plan Update

The committee worked to revise the MVCC Transportation Survey, after which a motion was voted upon and PASSED 7-0-0.

A secondary survey, to be conducted on-line and with a link from the first on-line survey, and authored primarily by Bill Pope with suggestions/alterations from the Committee, was passed 4-1-2.

b. T&I and Comm Plan: Discussion and an amended motion regarding a combined MVCC Venice Blvd and Transportation for input to the Palms - Mar Vista - Del Rey Community Plan Update

The motion was voted upon and PASSED 7-0-0.

c. T&I and Comm Plan: Discussion and possible motion requesting the Outreach Committee to promote and distribute the MVCC Venice Blvd, Transportation and/or the combined surveys to MVCC stakeholders

A list of suggestions for the MVCC Outreach Committee to help promote the survey was worded and voted upon, to be sent to the Board of Directors, and PASSED 6-0-0.
