## TRANSPORTATION?

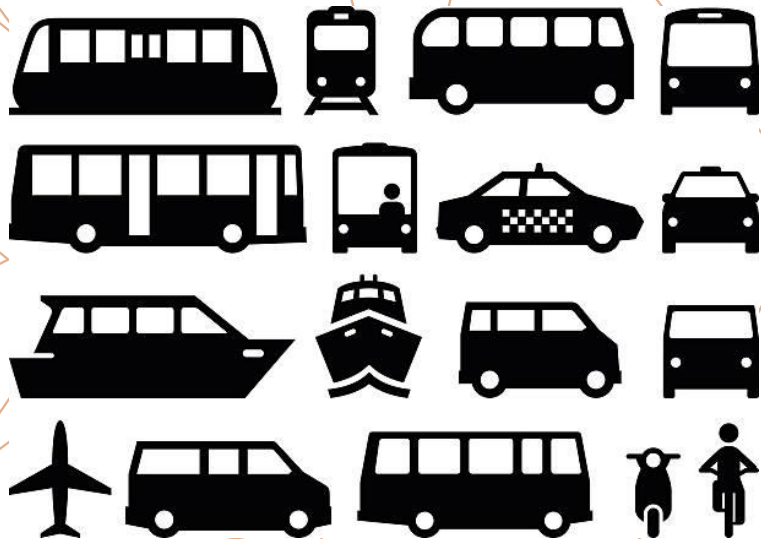
Any way someone gets around

18% of LA land mass = streets

Streets are 1/5<sup>th</sup> of our city's area, and millions of people use this public space every day

Median age = 35

We live in a younger community

Median household income=\$62K  
(\$2008)

For an average household of 2.3 ppl

60% of our residents are renters

Of occupied units. 40% owners
