Crime Trends & Prevention Tips :

Currently, there are two crime trends in the neighborhood and surrounding area: During the night, suspects target garages with glass panes. They break the pane and from there are able to

pull the emergency cord to open the garage. Then, they take bicycles and other property in the garage.

For residences with glass panes on the garage, please ensure your emergency cord is out of reach.

When the suspects strike during the night, they often hit three houses in one night.

Another crime trend are suspects target the elderly shopping at supermarkets.

When the victim is away from their shopping cart, even for a moment, the suspect takes the wallet.

Suspects even approached elderly victims in the parking lot, distract them, while the other person takes the debit card.

Inform women 55 years and up to remain vigilant at the super market.
